School Attendance

Last week our school Home School Liaison Officer – Glenyce Towers – had a meeting with staff to ensure we are following DEC guidelines with regard to school attendance.

Below is an excerpt from the department's guidelines in relation to late arrivals.

"Once enrolled, children are required to attend school each day it is open for students.

The importance of arriving on time

Arriving at school and class on time:

- Ensures that students do not miss out on important learning activities scheduled early in the day
- Helps students learn the importance of punctuality and routine
- Give students time to greet their friends before class
- Reduces classroom disruption

Lateness is recorded as a partial absence and must be explained by parents."

Students arriving after the bell or leaving early have to be registered as "unjustified" if there is no substantial reason given.

Unsubstantial reasons are those such as: late, car broken down, appointments (except medical appointments), sleeping in, etc.

The following table shows how quickly these small absences can add up!
