Dear Parents, Guardians, Carers and Friends of New Lambton Heights Infants School,

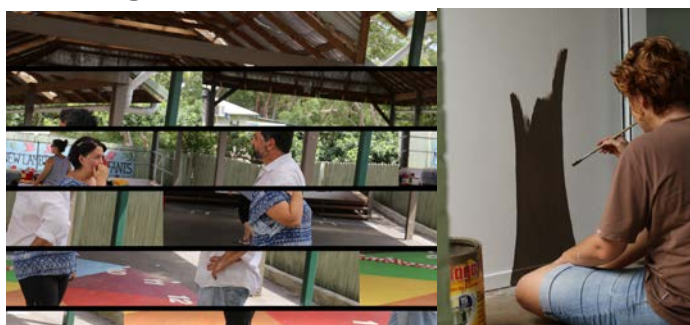
Great days - bit of rain, lots of sunshine and great big smiles from our happy students. Who could ask for more? Another magnificent week at New Lambton Heights Infants School.
