All classes will rotate through the play equipment. Please do not take children away from their group as staff are still legally responsible for students until they are marked off the roll.

Staff will be taking students to the toilets in groups. Please see a teacher if you are planning to take your child to the toilet.

As the Blackbutt staff are kindly letting us use the reserve for our school's fundraising purposes, I ask that you respect the reserve rules and use the bins allocated if you have any rubbish.

Students leaving with parents are required to let the staff know before leaving so rolls can be adjusted accordingly.

Monies raised by your child / children can be returned (along with the sponsor form) to the school on the day or before Tuesday, 2nd June.
