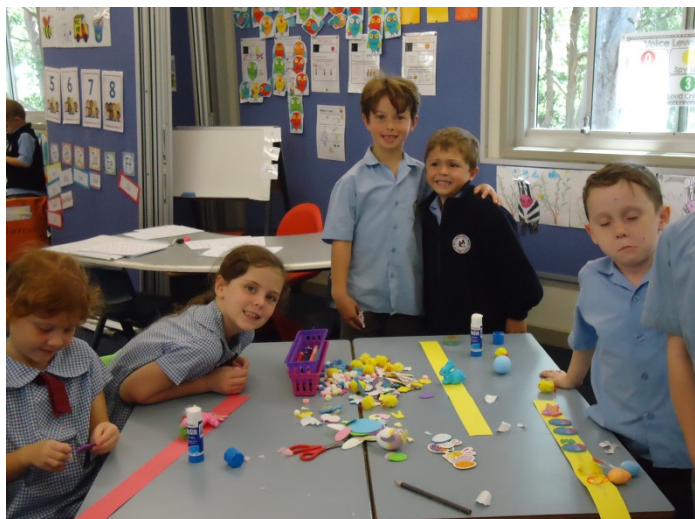


Parent Interviews
